

## How to use “Soto-yu” Public Baths in Shibu Onsen

### Guests staying at Ryokan Association hotels or inns in Shibu Onsen

At all of the 9 Soto-yu public baths you can take a bath free of charge.

■Operating Hours: 6:00am - 10:00pm

■How to make use of public bath houses: You need a key to open the door at each Soto-yu public bath, as they are usually locked. Keys to the public baths are available at your hotel or inn. Please enquire with staff. The key can be used at all 9 Soto-yu public baths. Entrance doors in the public baths are automatically and securely locked once closed. Please relax and enjoy your bath.

Please do not forget to return the key to your hotel or inn.

■Yukata: Feel free to walk around the streets in a “Yukata”.

### Day trip visitors (Those not staying at Ryokan Association hotels or inns in Shibu Onsen)

Of the nine public bath houses, only “O-yu” (大湯) No.9 is available for use if visiting on a day trip. A fee will be charged.

■Operating Hours: 10:00am - 4:00pm

■How to make use of the public bath house:

Please purchase a 500-yen hot spring ticket at the Shibu Onsen Information Center.

O-yu public bath house is always locked, and you will not be able to access the facility by yourself. Show your ticket at one of designated facilities listed below, and a staff member will escort you to the bath house and unlock the door for you. The door is automatically and securely locked once closed.

Please relax and enjoy your bath.

■Facilities designated to open O-yu public bath house:

Ryokan: Matsuya(松屋), Katei(果亭), Yumoto(湯本), Hishiya(ひしや), Kadoya(角屋), Kanaguya(金具屋), Ikariya(いかり屋)

Souvenir shops: Aiduya(会津屋), Komatsuya(小松屋)

Please check the location of the inns and stores with the key mark on the map on the reverse side. **key**

■Towels: If you need towels, you can purchase them at Aiduya(会津屋) or Komatsuya(小松屋).

■Please note: You are not allowed to wash your body or hair in the bath itself; please rinse yourself with onsen water using the small buckets provided before getting in.

**Koishiya 小石屋**  
(Western-style restaurant)



Opening Hours: 7:30am-9:30am  
6:00pm-10:30pm  
Closed: Not fixed

For breakfast, why not try something from the range of popular sandwiches and coffees, and in the evening, enjoy specialty dishes made from locally sourced produce with a craft beer or wine.



**Ramen Tokumi ラーメン徳味**  
(Ramen shop)



Opening Hours: 11:00am-1:30pm  
5:30pm-11:30pm  
Closed: Tuesdays

Ramen noodles are the most popular food for Japanese people when eating out. Be sure to try some! We also recommend you sample the pork cutlet with egg on rice, Chinese fried rice, fried gyoza dumplings, and fried potatoes.



**Izakaya Shibu 居酒屋 しぶ**  
(Japanese style bar)



Opening Hours: 6:00pm-1:00am  
(approx.)  
Closed: Not fixed

You can order both drinks and food on the menu, or make a request for dishes not on the menu. We aim to serve you in a warm, comfortable atmosphere.

(Japanese restaurant)



Opening Hours: 11:30am-2:30pm  
5:30pm-10:00pm  
Closed: Wednesdays, Thursdays

A range of Japanese dishes including sashimi, tempura, fried chicken, and fried potato, as well as meal sets, snacks, and alcohol.



**Yariya やりや**  
(Soba noodle restaurant)  
※Soba (buckwheat noodles)



Opening Hours: 11:00am-4:00pm  
6:00pm-11:00pm  
Closed: Not fixed

In Yariya you can try not only cold or warm Soba noodles, but also Udon noodles or fried chicken pieces (Karaage). You will find great service, friendly owners and reasonable prices.
